TITLE: Advancement of the Health of all people through Education

WHEREAS, the Environmental Protection Agency has classified secondhand smoke as a Class A carcinogen and therefore concludes that second hand smokers a health risk to non-smokers, and

WHEREAS, public places and work sites are locations where both members of the community and employees of those establishments are exposed to second hand smoke, and

WHEREAS, a ventilation system may reduce the amount of visible smoke in a work site or public place yet not eliminate the harmful particles that are left behind, and

WHEREAS, non-smoking sections do not eliminate non-smoker's exposure to second hand smoke, and

WHEREAS, a clean indoor air policy is a public health issue and we have the right, and the responsibility, to work to improve the health of our people and others, and


WHEREAS, the Grand Camp Alaska Native Brotherhood and Alaska Native Sisterhood is an organization that advocates for good public health policy, now

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Alaska Native Brotherhood and the Alaska Native Sisterhood in convention in Ketchikan, Alaska on October 3, 2003 adopt this resolution and advocate the advancement of the health of all people through education


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT in working toward this goal, the Grand Camp of Alaska Native Brotherhood and Alaska Native Sisterhood endorses clean indoor air policies which protect the community from further health risks

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED THAT this resolution shall be sent to the governor of the State of Alaska, the Commissioner of Health and Social Services, our state legislators, and all southeast municipalities.
