TITLE: Alcohol & Drug Problems

WHEREAS, SEARHC has the Gunaanasti (Bill Brady Healing Center) for adults, Yeil Jeeyax (Raven's Way) for adolescents, and Deilee Hit (Safe Harbor House) for women and children to help meet some needs for people suffering with the disease of alcoholism and drug addiction and that data has indicated that these programs are successful in helping people, and

WHEREAS, there is a need for more funding to continue and expand these important programs to include recovery, outpatient, family counseling, and transitional living for women and children, and

WHEREAS, these problems are present and far reaching in all families and friends, and

WHEREAS, there is a continuing need for adequate education to train personnel to work in this field, now
