TITLE: Endorse improvement of the Grand Camp scholarship process

WHEREAS, the Alaska Native Brotherhood Grand Camp (Grand Camp) has long recognized and supported the native youth in advancement in education, and

WHEREAS, it is recognized that Grand Camp has funding for youth who choose to pursue advancing their education through scholarships, and

WHEREAS, it is also recognized the scholarship is funded in part by donations made from Grand Camp's gaming permit and investments, and

WHEREAS, it is also recognized Grand Camp has distributed education scholarships by way of those who applied to the Grand Camp scholarship committee who reside in Juneau, and

WHEREAS, the Grand Camp scholarship committee is a vital and important committee, and

WHEREAS, there is need for more access to the education scholarships of Grand Camp, and

WHEREAS, local Camps are more knowledgeable of those who wish to pursue education in their respective communities, and

WHEREAS, residents of Juneau on Grand Camp's scholarship committee have done an admirable job, however, the local Camps would go further in enhancing education from those in their communities by being on the Grand Camp scholarship committee, now

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Alaska Native Brotherhood and the Alaska Native Sisterhood in convention in Ketchikan, Alaska on October 3, 2003 adopt this resolution and will have an equal opportunity process for individuals from other villages that are seeking funding and will encourage our youth to apply.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Grand Camp scholarship application and deadline will be made available to our youth and the process of scholarship availability will be reevaluated

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED THAT this resolution will be sent to every local camp committee and all the ANB and ANS Executive committee members and grand officers.
