Whereas, the smoke free program has been successfully implemented at the Sitka ANB/ANS Hall and Sitka Tribe of Alaska, and


Whereas, many business establishments, hospitals, restaurants, bingo halls and schools have successfully implemented smoke free establishments, and

Whereas, we want our children, grandchildren, and everyone to be given an opportunity to breathe smoke free air, and


Whereas, ANB and ANS camps have successfully helped in many health issues throughout the years, now
