Title: Support increased state funding in Social Services for drug and alcohol counseling


WHEREAS, the Alaska Native Brotherhood (ANB) has long advocated for the social health and welfare of our Alaska Native people, and

WHEREAS, it is recognized that social services have helped the betterment of our Alaska Native people in the area of health and welfare, where necessary, by way of excellent counseling programs, and

WHEREAS, over the recent years, especially this last year, the state of Alaska has significantly cut the social services budget to where there is not an adequately funded amount to take care of the necessary needs, now

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Alaska Native Brotherhood and the Alaska Native Sisterhood in convention in Ketchikan, Alaska on October 3, 2003 adopt this resolution and ask that the state of Alaska is called upon to increase the social services budget to adequately fund the needs of drug and alcohol counseling in our communities.
