Title: Larger Health Facility

WHEREAS, SEARHC has been doing a commendable job in providing health care for our Native people in Southeast Alaska; and

WHEREAS, most health facilities currently being used in each village, including Kake, have been in existence for several years now, serving more and more people; and

WHEREAS, as is the normal trend, these communities have been growing as the years go by; and

WHEREAS, because of this inevitable, the current facilities are now proving to be barely adequate to serve the people as efficiently as they once could, crowded waiting rooms, insufficient office/records space,
now

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Alaska Native Brotherhood and the Alaska Native Sisterhood in convention in Ketchikan, Alaska on October 3, 2003 adopt this resolution and strongly urge SEARHC to look closely at this problem and take the necessary steps to rectify this problem by making plans to enlarge these facilities adequately.


