Title: Charter Boat Halibut Fishing

WHEREAS, halibut are being caught by charter boat fishermen, and

WHEREAS, the halibut caught by said fishermen can be smaller than those caught by commercial fishermen,
now

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT charter boat fishermen adhere to the same 32 inches length size requirements as those caught by commercial vessels and subsistence fisherman, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the halibut caught by charter boats be limited to two (2) per day per person; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the taking of halibut in these spawning grounds areas be prohibited

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED THAT the Alaska Native Brotherhood and the Alaska Native Sisterhood in convention in Ketchikan, Alaska on October 3, 2003 adopt this resolution and advocate that halibut less than 32 inches in length caught by charter boats be prohibited.
