TITLE: Assistance to Wrangell to build a new community hall

WHEREAS, the Wrangell ANB Hall was destroyed by fire thirty years ago on February 13, 1973, and

WHEREAS, the Wrangell Camp of the Alaska Native Brotherhood and Alaska Native Sisterhood has found it necessary to rent facilities for all ANB and ANS functions due to the lack of their own facilities, and

WHEREAS, the original Corner Posts which came from the Tribal House on Shakes Island are in need of a safe place of storage which could be provided in a new community hall, and

WHEREAS, due to the declining membership created by the great loss of Wrangell's community hall the group has not been successful in raising the necessary funds to replace their hall, and


WHEREAS, the entire Native Community of Wrangell is in need of a large facility in which to hold community functions as well as attract conventions to help bolster the declining economy, now

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Alaska Native Brotherhood and the Alaska Native Sisterhood in convention in Ketchikan, Alaska on October 3, 2003 adopt this resolution and support the Wrangell Camps of the Alaska Native Brotherhood and Alaska Native Sisterhood in their efforts to seek funds to replace their community hall, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Grand Camp will actively assist Wrangell with contacting funding agencies for available grants including state and federal agencies to be used in building a new community hall.
